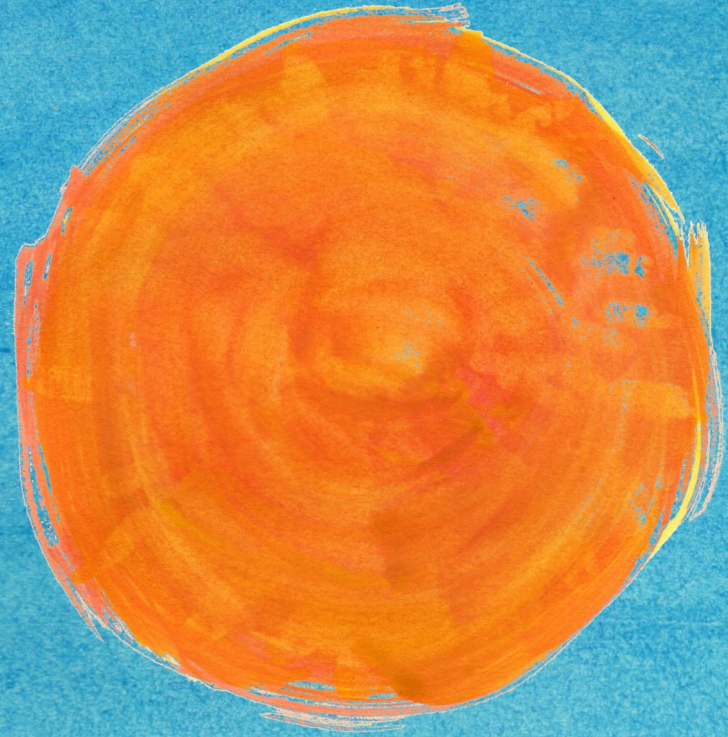




**Can Icinit Go

find one.

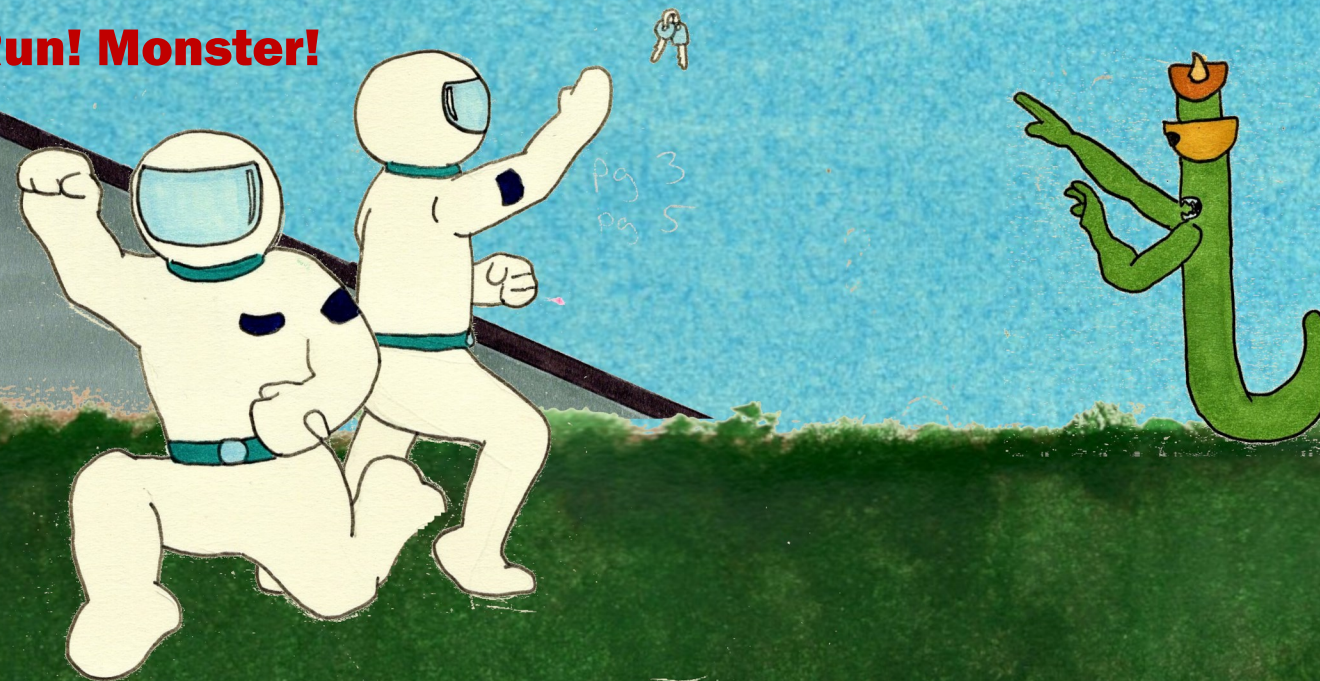

Run! Monster!




**Incit boarded the ship.

on toward the sun.**

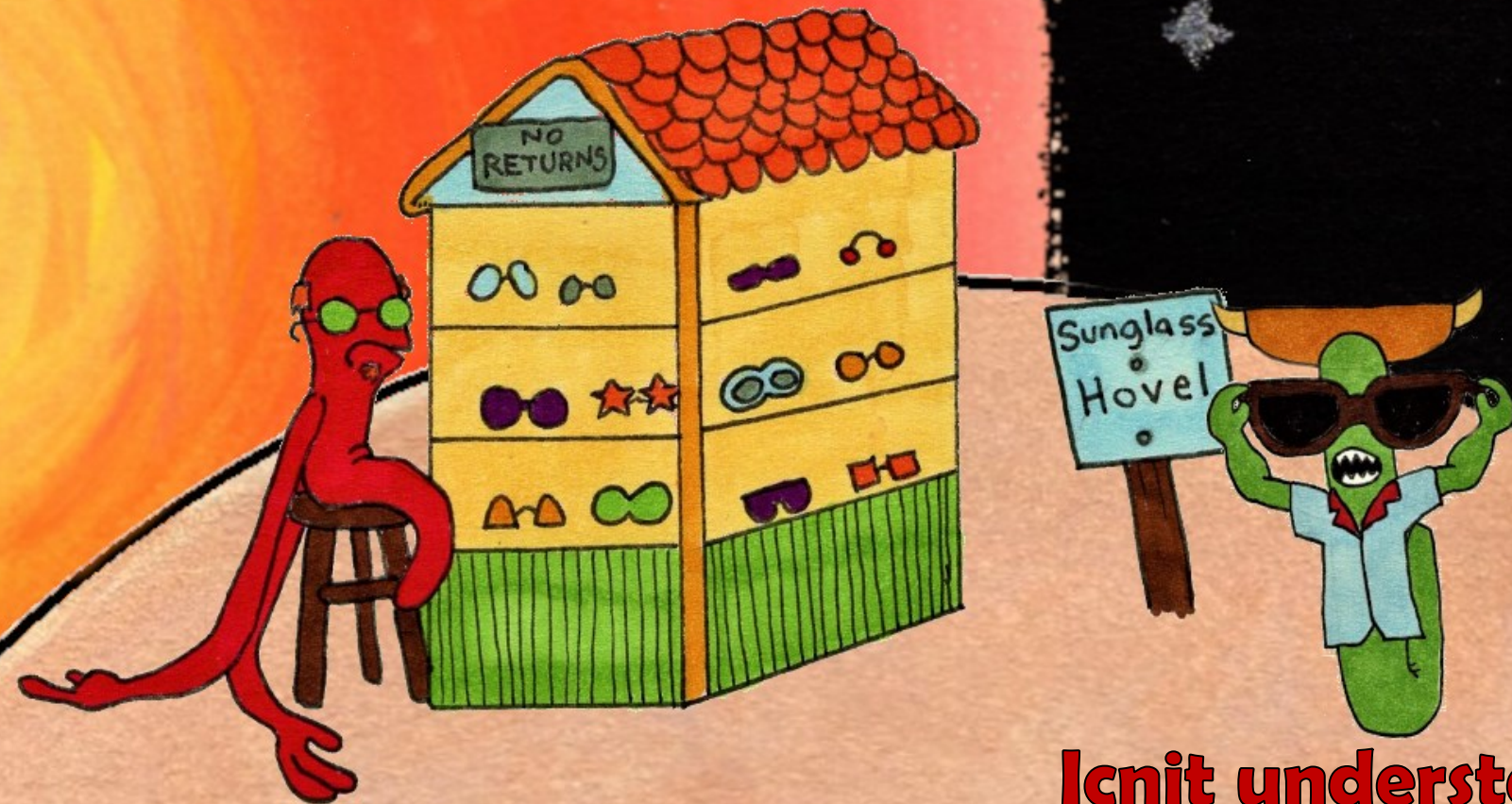
Then Icnit spotted Venus.




Incit was very interested in fashion and wanted to look his best for the sun, so he stopped to buy a fresh shirt.



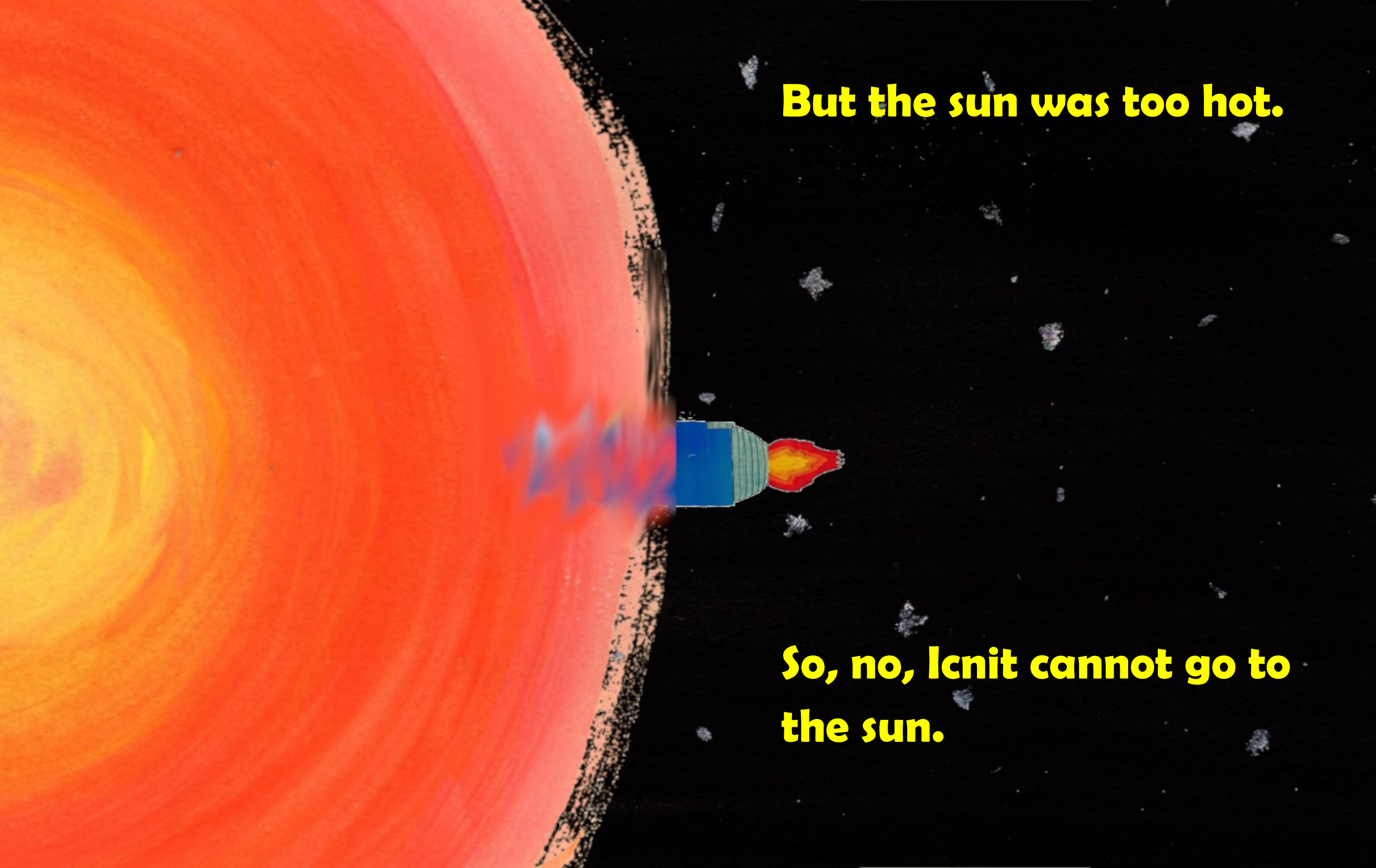
Next up was Mercury, the best place in the solar system for sunglasses.



Incit understood the importance of protecting his eyes from harmful UV rays. Safety first!

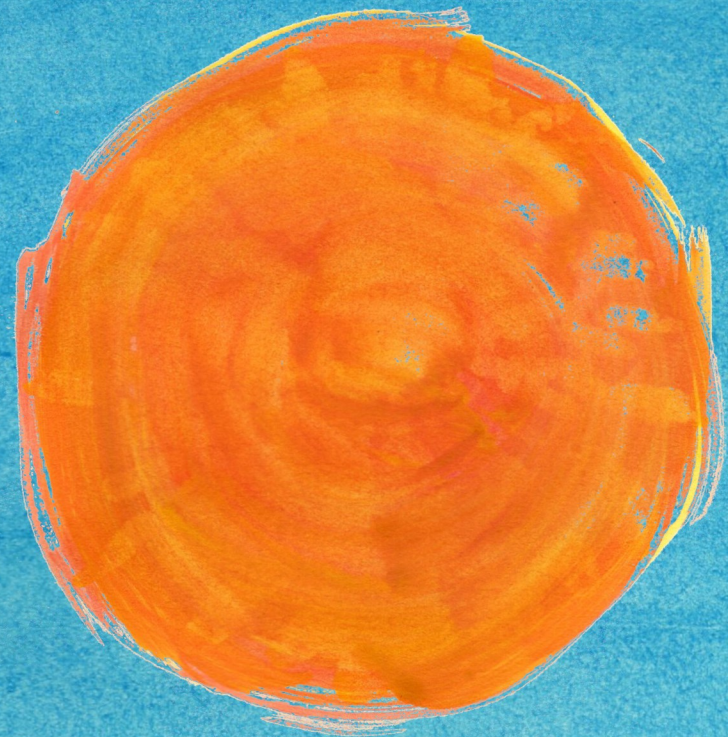


**Then it was onward

the sun.**

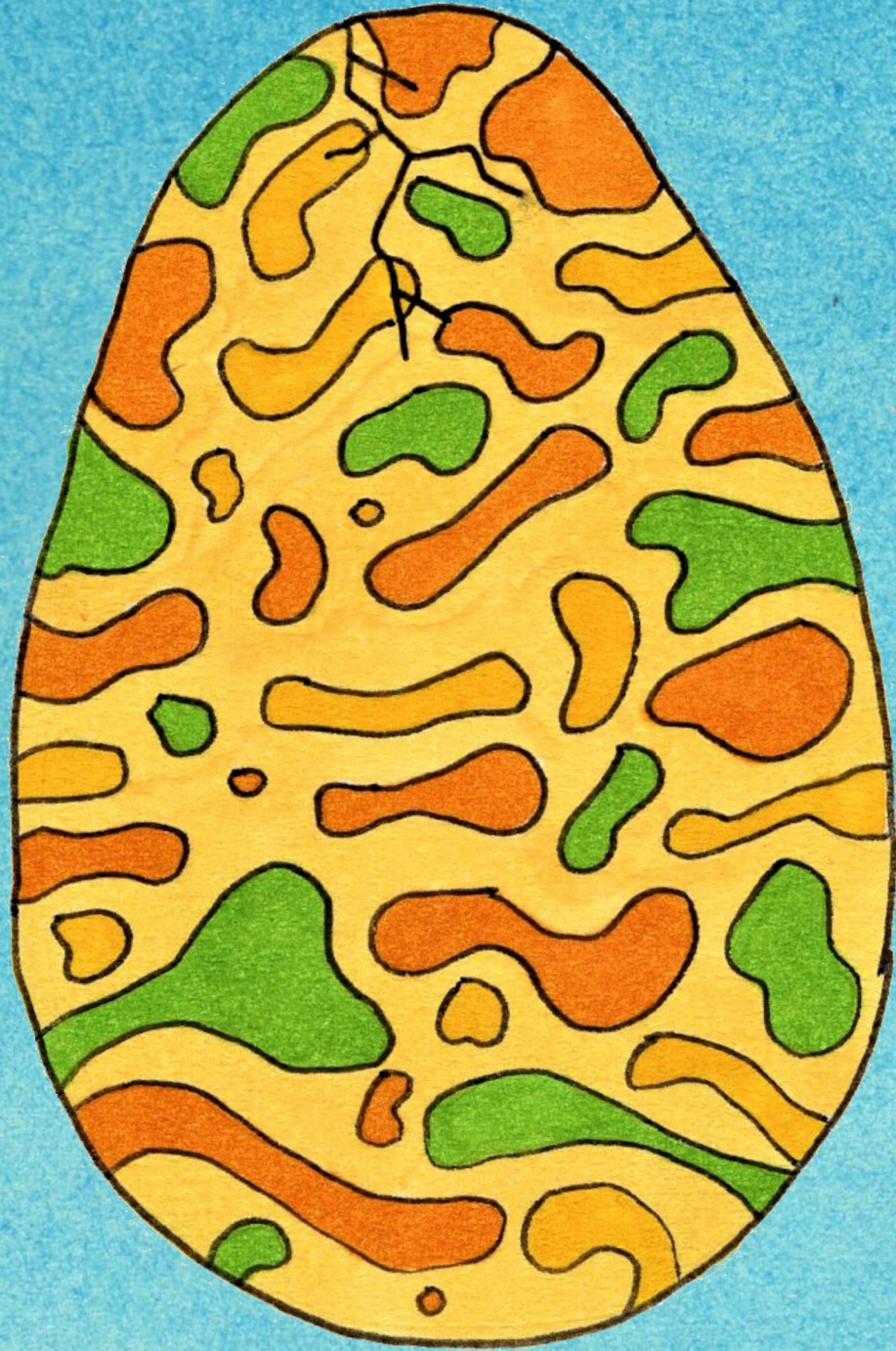


**But Icnit, who is eternal,
